Please note the suggested list below to ensure a positive start to our residential;

- > Please arrive at 7.30am on Monday morning and bring your bags into the hall. Please see Mrs Blount (St John the Baptist CE Primary School & Nursery) or Mr Field (Bomere Heath CE Primary School) to hand in any medicines with your consent form (consent form is attached).
- > Make sure your child has a packed your lunch and drink in a rucksack to keep with them. Children are allowed to bring snacks, biscuits and cakes as treats for the evening but we will put these together so we can all share in the evening to ensure no one goes without. (Please provide allergy information if anything is home baked). We will be supplying the children with hot chocolate/drink in the evening before bedtime.
- > The children should wear school sweatshirts on Monday morning. They are welcome to wear comfortable trousers or skirts and are not otherwise expected to wear uniform, although we would ask that any clothes are appropriate as representatives of the schools within our federation.
