

# Bomere Heath CE Primary School

## Results 2018

### Key Stage 2

Pupils are assessed against the new National Curriculum and results are reported as a scaled score from 80 - 120 and teacher assessments based on the standards in the new framework. A high (greater depth) score is 110 or above. Our school results are shown below, together with the National Average in brackets.

Caution has to be given to data in percentages as we had a small cohort in key stage two this year; each child counts for just over 9%. In Key Stage one, each pupil counts for just over 5%.
