

English

We will be adopting a mastery approach to teaching English that embeds the fundamental skills for each year group including spelling, grammar and punctuation. The children will be focusing on their independent editing skills and producing longer pieces of writing across several genres.

Maths

We follow a mastery approach to learning, that allows the children to work at a slower pace to underpin a deeper understanding of maths. They will develop deep reasoning and problem solving skills. We also focus heavily on times tables and related division facts from $\times 2$, $\times 3$, $\times 4$, $\times 5$, $\times 6$, $\times 8$, $\times 10$, $\times 11$.
