Year 3s

$1 \times 3 = 3$

$2 \times 3 = 6$

$3 \times 3 = 9$

$4 \times 3 = 12$

Year 4s

$1 \times 7 = 7$

$2 \times 7 = 14$

$3 \times 7 = 21$

$4 \times 7 = 28$

Please continue to practise times tables from previous year groups – year 3s x 2 x 5 x 10, year 4s x 2 x 3 x 4 x 5 x 6 x 8 x 10
