Vocabulary:

Sculpture	an artistic form in which hard or plastic materials are worked into three-dimensional art objects.
Statue	a solid figure made from metal, stone, or other hard materials, usually with the objective of appearing lifelike.
3D	Three dimensional art with all the dimensions of height, width, and depth
Land art	made directly in the landscape by sculpting the land itself or by making structures in the landscape with natural materials
Sculptor	artist who creates sculptures
Carving	the act of using tools to shape something from a material by scraping away portions of that material.
Abstract	art that does not represent an accurate representation of the actual thing
Geometric	Shapes which are precise and regular, like square, and triangle
