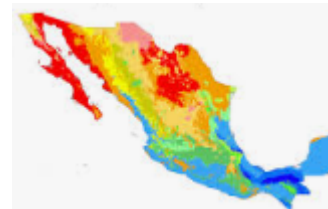
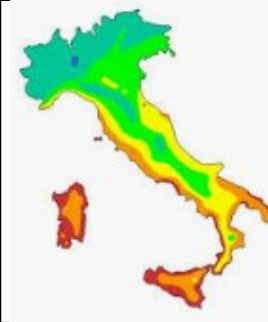
Using the Exploring Science Units, the children will be covering units titled:
